Chief Executive Carrie Lam**Graces Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Bay Area Gala Dinner**

Jointly organised by the Federation of Hong Kong Industries (FHKI), Hong Kong Productivity Council (HKPC) and FHKI's Pearl River Delta Council (PRD Council), the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Bay Area Gala Dinner 2018 was successfully held in Zhuhai today (Monday). Officials from the Governments of Guangdong Province, Zhuhai City, Hong Kong SAR, Macau SAR as well as business leaders from the Mainland, Hong Kong and Macau exchanged their ideas on new opportunities for the development Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Bay Area. Chief Executive of the Hong Kong SAR Government Carrie Lam attended the Gala Dinner as the Guest-of-Honour and gave a welcoming speech. Other guests including leadership of Guangdong Province and Zhuhai also gave their welcoming remarks.

Following the commissioning of the Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge, this year's Gala Dinner highlights the 40th anniversary of reform and opening up and I&T development in the Bay Area. The dinner also outlines that Guangdong, Hong Kong and Macau have advanced to a new stage of co-operation under the development of Bay Area. FHKI Chairman Jimmy Kwok said in his speech, "For the purpose of fostering co-operation among Guangdong, Hong Kong and Macau, the Gala Dinner is the largest business event held in Zhuhai after the commissioning of Hong Kong-Zhuhai-Macao Bridge. It is particularly meaningful as it is our first time to have the government officials and business sectors from Macau attending the event. To create "a world-class Bay Area and an international city cluster", the business sectors of Guangdong, Hong Kong and Macau should join hands with the Governments in an effort to promote flow of talents, goods, capital and information."

An Awards Presentation Ceremony for celebrating the 40th Anniversary of Reform and Opening Up also took place during the Gala Dinner. It was to praise the Hong Kong manufacturers, who invested in the Mainland at early stage, for their contributions to the economic growth and development of the Mainland. Awardees included Hong Kong manufacturer Lam Leung, FHKI Honorary Presidents Prof Cliff Sun and Dr Roy Chung, PRD Council Vice Presidents Yeung Fan and Arnald Ho and more. FHKI Honorary President the Hon Andrew Leung said during the Presentation Ceremony, "As President Xi said, the role of Hong Kong and Macau in national development is getting increasingly important.
